# SAIS Statement: Welcoming Anti-Discrimination Legislative Changes

On Tuesday 27 November, the ACT Legislative Assembly passed changes to the ACT Discrimination Act 1991. SAIS welcomes the changes that limit the use of exemptions for protected attributes in schools and educational institutes, while still allowing schools the right to serve specific religious communities.

We are optimistic that ACT Schools will see the reform as an opportunity to reaffirm school values of inclusion and anti-discrimination, review policy frameworks to ensure inclusive practice is embedded, and have open conversations with students and families about what kind of community they want to be.

### **ACHPER ACT Professional Learning Seminar**

In October, SAIS presented to primary school health and PE teachers at the ACHPER ACT PL learning event. We explored transgender and gender diverse inclusion in primary school physical education. We suggested bringing a 'gendered lens' to this area of work. Some top hints include:

- Reflect on our own and others gendered assumptions and bias
- Encourage critical thinking about gendered stereotypes
- Notice who is participating and in what ways
- Call out teasing and encourage positive behaviours
- Create a culture of shared responsibility
